Ann Lee is a former investment banker and hedge fund partner, as well as the author of *What the U.S. Can Learn from China: An Open-Minded Guide to Treating Our Greatest Competitor as Our Greatest Teacher*. She is an adjunct professor of economics and finance at New York University and a frequent media commentator on global economic issues, finance, and U.S.-China relations. In addition to television and radio appearances on MSNBC, Bloomberg, ABC, CBS, CNN, CNBC, Fox Business, and NPR, her op-eds have appeared in such publications as *The New York Times*, *The Financial Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Newsweek*, *Businessweek*, *Forbes*, *Harvard Business Review*, *The American Prospect*, and *The American Banker*. She has been quoted in hundreds of publications and has been an invited speaker at numerous industry and academic conferences.

Ann was visiting professor at Peking University where she taught macroeconomics and financial derivatives. While teaching at Peking University, she also acted as an economic adviser to Chinese economic officials, as well as to several large Chinese asset management firms. She was educated at U.C. Berkeley, Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of International Affairs, and Harvard Business School. Ann is an alumna of the 2012 Young Leaders Conference of the American Swiss Foundation.
